SPEAK OUT FOR ENGINEERING

Speak Out for Engineering is your opportunity to give a presentation on an engineering topic of your choice to a panel of judges from Industry and Academia, in a competition against other Young Members from the area

The competition is open to Affiliate Members, Associate Members, and those Members who have been professionally registered for 10 years or less, and is aimed at promoting the ability to effectively communicate mechanical engineering subjects.

Competitors will give an oral presentation on a subject of their choice relating to mechanical engineering to a judging panel and small audience. The duration of the presentation must not exceed 20 minutes, with a further 10 minutes allowed for questions from the panel. As the focus of the competition is on effective communication, 90% of the marks are given for presentation style, with only 10% for technical content.

As well as being a great opportunity to develop your presenting skills, and to network with those from the engineering profession, the competition winner and runner up will receive the following prizes:

1st place: £300 + certificate

2nd place: £200 + certificate

All competitors will receive a certificate

Panelists are to be confirmed, and will include a selection of academics and engineering professionals from the local area. The event is to be held over two heats in the area, with the winner and runner up being notified once both events have taken place.

After submission of a short synopsis, presenters will be selected to present at either a Bath or Bristol heat (please indicate your preference when submitting your entry).

Heat 1: University of Bath, 27th March 2014, 6:00pm onwards

Heat 2: University of Bristol, 31st March 2014, 6:00pm onwards
